REGISTRATION POLICIES

For REC Players:

No requests as to what teams my child will play on, what nights they are available to play or who they will play with can be expected to be met, regardless of carpooling or previous coaches. All Soccer strive to keep teams together for one season (fall/spring), where after they will be re-organized based on ranking, skill, age and years played, however this cannot be guaranteed. In addition coaches are allowed to select practice locations other than Bailey road within reasonable distance.

INTERESTED IN SELECT COMPETITION?

We will be holding open tryouts for select teams. Each player/parent must complete a Medical Release Form prior to participating in any tryouts. There is no cost for the tryouts.

PLEASE REGISTER ONLY AFTER BEING CONTACTED BY A SELECT COACH. Any player who has paid for registration at a recreational level will be charged the difference (\$400 - \$130 = \$270) prior to being placed on a select team roster.

Fees & Refund Policy:

Registration Fees:

Your registration fees cover costs associated with insurance, trophies, referee fees, field operations, and club operation fees. Registration form must be completed and all fees paid (unless payment plan is selected - SELECT only) before player is placed on team.

The preferred method of payment is via credit card entered into GotSoccer during the time of registration. Checks made payable to AIYS will be accepted only during in-person registration events. A FEE OF \$35.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS. A LATE FEE OF \$25.00 PER CHILD WILL BE ASSESSED AFTER LAST REGISTRATION DATE.

Refunds:

Refunds will be processed upon request minus any incurred costs (e.g., FYSA registration fees, etc.). A Request for Refund form should be completed by the player's parents and forwarded to the club for processing. No refunds will be granted after the start of the season.

IMPORTANT CHANGE - Uniform Policy:

Each player will be required to purchase their individual uniforms through Soccer.com for recreational (approximately \$40) or Florida Blast for select (approximately \$160). Once recreational team rosters are established, you will receive an email a 3-4 weeks prior to the start of the season with the ordering details. For select players, the ordering details will be provided by your coach.

Parent Volunteer - MANDATORY

Each parent is required to volunteer, 3 hours per player per season. Volunteer hours allow the club to successfully operate by ensuring the fields and facilities are in good working order and to raise funds for the club operation. Any hours not worked will be charged at \$25 per hour not served.

Buy-Out Option

A buyout of \$25 may be paid at the start of the season in lieu of working the volunteer hours.

Shrimp Festival Parking Fundraiser

Please note that you CANNOT buy-out of Shrimp Festival duties. Even if you buy-out you will still need to work Shrimp Festival.

Sibling Discounts:

A discount for registration fees will be provided to siblings only after the first full price registration is paid. No discount will be given for a sibling if a reduced-fee or free voucher is used to pay for registration.

FYSA CODE OF ETHICS

Players

- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at all times.
- I will remember that soccer is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol; and expect everyone to refrain from their use at all soccer games.
- I will do the best I can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- I will treat my coaches, other players and coaches, game officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times; regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will concentrate on playing soccer. Always giving my best effort.
- I will play by the rules at all times.
- I will at all times control my temper, resisting the temptation of retaliation.
- I will always exercise self-control.
- Conduct during competition towards play of the game and all officials shall be in accordance with appropriate behavior and in accordance with FIFA's "Laws of the Game," and in adherence to FYSA rules.
- While traveling, shall conduct themselves so as to being credit to themselves and their team.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.

Coaches/Volunteers

- I will never place the value of winning before the safety and welfare of all players.
- I will always show respect for players, other coaches, and game officials.
- I will lead by example, demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship at all times.
- I will be demonstrate knowledgeable of the rules of the game, and teach these rules to my players.
- I will never use abusive or insulting language. I will treat everyone with dignity.
- I will not tolerate inappropriate behavior, regardless of the situation.
- I will not allow the use of anabolic agents or stimulants, drugs, tobacco, or alcohol by any of my players.
- I will never knowingly jeopardize the eligibility and participation of a student-athlete.
- Youth have a greater need for example than criticism. I will be the primary soccer role model.
- I will at all times conduct myself in a positive manner.
- Coaching is motivating players to produce their best effort, inspiring players to learn, and encouraging players to be winners.
- Coach's actions on sidelines during games shall be in the spirit of "good sportsmanship" at all times. Profanity, profane gestures, arguing, inciting disruptive behavior by spectators and/or players, or any conduct not in the spirit of good sportsmanship, shall require disciplinary action from the affiliate.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.
- I will refrain from any activity or conduct that may be detrimental or reflect adversely upon FYSA, its members or its programs.
- I will accurately and completely complete the coach/volunteer application form and by application attest to the accuracy of the information submitted.

Parents/Spectators

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials, and administrators at all times.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and fans with respect.
- I will always be positive.
- I will always allow the coach to be the only coach.
- I will not get into arguments with the opposing team's parents, players, or coaches.
- I will not come onto the field for any reason during the game.
- I will not criticize game officials.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any game or at any other time at the field and/or game complex.
- I will refrain from any activity or conduct that may be detrimental or reflect adversely upon FYSA, its members or its programs.

Failure to comply may result in the suspension of your privilege to participate in FYSA sanctioned events, for the following periods:

- 1st offense -- suspension for a minimum of thirty (30) days to a maximum of five (5) years.
- 2nd offense -- suspension for a minimum of one (1) year to a maximum of ten (10) years.
- 3rd offense -- suspension for a minimum of five (5) years to a maximum of fifty (50) years.
- NOTE: Any individual charged with a violation of this Code of Ethics shall be afforded due process as defined in FYSA's Rule 600 before the implementation of any suspension.
